

Lent 5: "Giving Up Our Prejudices"

Jonah 3.10 - 4.11

1. Recognize that God's **GRACE** and **MERCY** is not just for **ME**.

2. See yourself as **PART** of the **PROBLEM**.

The heart is deceitful above all things and beyond cure. Who can understand it?
Jeremiah 17.9

But the things that come out of a person's mouth come from the heart, and these defile them. For out of the heart come evil thoughts—murder, adultery, sexual immorality, theft, false testimony, slander.

Matthew 15.18-19

Create in me a clean heart, O God. Renew a loyal spirit within me.

3. Believe there is good in the **OTHER SIDE**.

4. Understand that the laws in **GOD'S KINGDOM** may be different than **YOURS**.

5. I need to care more about **PEOPLE** than **ME** or **MY STUFF**.

Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others.
