- A. Jesus shares what is most important in life--the most important commandment from God that we should follow:

“Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.’ This is the first and greatest commandment.”

Why is Worship important? God wants us to worship because...

1. of **WHO GOD IS**. (v1-4) *“Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory.”*

2. it **WAKES US UP** (v5) *“Woe to me!” I cried. “I am ruined!*

3. of what God **HAS DONE FOR US**. (v6-7) *your guilt is taken away and your sin atoned for*

4. it gives us **ASSURANCE** (v8) *Then I heard the voice of the Lord*

5. it’s a **WITNESS** to the rest **OF THE WORLD** (v8)
“Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?”
