REFUELING

John 4.4-38

How to refuel like Jesus. How to maintain proper sustenance on our Journey with Jesus.

1. Like Jesus, consume lots of Scripture.

'Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God...' Matthew 4.4

...but whoever drinks the water I give them will never thirst. John 4.14

...my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4.19

2. Keep your eyes open and look for opportunities to serve.

...open your eyes and look at the fields! They are ripe for harvest. John 4.35

3. Don't give up until it's over.

"My food," said Jesus, "is to do the will of him who sent me and to finish his work." John 4.34

Therefore we do not lose heart. Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day. For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all. So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen, since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal.
