What Pentecost teaches us about the Power of the Holy Spirit.

1. The Holy Spirit enables us to **TRANSCEND DIFFERENCES**.

Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love. Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace. Ephesians 4.2-3

2. The Holy Spirit speaks to us WHEREVER WE ARE.

In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us through wordless groans... Romans 8.26

3. The Holy Spirit gives us HOLY BOLDNESS.

For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power... 2 Timothy 1.7

4. The Holy Spirit leads us to **SALVATION**.

Those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand were added to their number that day. Acts 2.41
