3. Take God's past working in your life and <a href="PROJECT IT">PROJECT IT</a> into your **FUTURE**. "The Lord will fight for you..." v. 14

4. Make time to <u>DO NOTHING</u>. "The Lord will fight for you; you need only to be still." v. 15

5. Don't just do nothing, but proceed living AS JESUS WOULD. "Tell the Israelites to move on..." v.15

6. **PRAISE GOD** all the time. "And I will gain glory..." v.17
