DO YOU ALWAYS WANT THIS BREAD?

EXODUS 16.13-36, JOHN 6.25-69

God will provide food and water for the Israelites during their entire experience in the wilderness. Exodus 16.13-36

This point in Israel's history becomes a point of debate between Jesus and his hearers in John 6.

Jesus has just performed the miracle of feeding of the 5000. The people think about their ancestors in the wilderness and how they too received bread from heaven. The people want more and they tell Jesus, "*always give us this bread.*" John 6.34

Jesus challenges his hearers, "*I am the Bread of Life*" (v. 35, 48, 51) that has come down from heaven (v. 38).

Woah! The people and leaders think they know enough already to question Jesus' assertion. They grumble, debate and argue (v. 41, 52) and many of his disciples turned back and no longer followed him (v. 66).

"Everyone who has heard the Father and learned from him comes to me."

John 6.45
