**THE 10 COMMANDMENTS: PART 2
TURNED TOWARD THE NEIGHBOR
EXODUS 20.12-17**

A review about the commandments:

- 1. Keeping the Commandments doesn't save you.
- 2. The commandments are not meant to restrict us but to protect and provide for us.
- 3. The commandments were written to and for the people of God.
- 4. Keeping the commandments is the way to understand God better.

Last week we covered the first four commandments which dealt with our relationship with God.

The remaining six commandments address our relationship with others.

Jesus replied: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'" Matthew 22.37-39

- 5. Honor your father and mother.
We will honor and respect our parents.

- 6. Do not murder.
We will not hate people or hurt others with our words and actions.

- 7. Do not commit adultery.
We will respect our bodies and the bodies of other people.

- 8. Do not steal.
We will not take what doesn't belong to us.

- 9. Do not give false testimony.
We will tell the truth.

- 10. Do not covet.
We will be thankful for God's good gifts to us.

*You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, serve one another humbly in love. **For the entire law is fulfilled in keeping this one command: "Love your neighbor as yourself."*** Galatians 5.13-14
