JESUS' FINAL COMMAND TO THE DISCIPLES:

Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. Matthew 28.19-20

How do we know when we have arrived as a 'disciple' of Jesus?

SIX IMPORTANT MARKS OF DISCIPLESHIP

1st Mark: Daily Bible Reading and Prayer

To the Jews who had believed him, Jesus said, "If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." John 8.31-32

"Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock." Matthew 7.24
