

THE DANGER OF DRIFT

John 21.1-14

The disciple's excitement of Jesus' resurrection and post-resurrection experiences has passed. They miss Jesus. Instead of obeying Jesus' command to go out into the world and continue his God-movement (John 20.21), they have drifted back into what they were familiar with....fishing. But they catch nothing.

THE DANGER OF DRIFT IN OUR SPIRITUAL LIVES:

*"I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; **apart from me you can do nothing. If you do not remain in me, you are like a branch that is thrown away and withers; such branches are picked up, thrown into the fire and burned.**"* John 15.5-6

HOW TO AVOID DRIFT:

- Get **SICK AND TIRED** of being **SICK AND TIRED**.
- Admit **DEFEAT** .

- Remember the **GOOD OLE DAYS!**

- Listen anew **FOR THE VOICE OF JESUS** .

- Do **WHAT JESUS SAYS** .

- Look forward to **FELLOWSHIP** with **JESUS** again.
