SO, YOU THINK YOU LOVE JESUS?

John 21.15-25

In this final scene from the book of John, Jesus spends some time with Peter and by asking him one painful question—multiple times—Jesus restores him to the fold and recommissions him to continue God's Kingdom work.

"Yes, Lord, you know that I love you." John 21.16

SO, YOU THINK YOU LOVE JESUS:

1. FEEDING: Am I HELPING OTHERS? Feed my sheep v15-17

And do not forget to do good and to share with others, for with such sacrifices God is pleased. Hebrews 13.16

4. FOCUS: Does Jesus <u>HAVE</u> FIRST <u>PLACE</u> in my life? ...what is that to you? You must follow me." v22

Therefore, holy brothers and sisters, who share in the heavenly calling, fixyour thoughts on Jesus.Hebrews 3.1

So if you're serious about living this new resurrection life with Christ, act like it. Pursue the things over which Christ presides. Don't shuffle along, eyes to the ground, absorbed with the things right in front of you. Look up, and be alert to what is going on around Christ—that's where the action is. See things from his perspective. Colossians 3.1-2 MSG
