

**THE LIFE OF DAVID:  
UNHINGED WORSHIP**  
*2 Samuel 6*

David is now king over a united Israel. His first order of business, after making Jerusalem the capital city, is to move the ark of the covenant, the concrete sign of God’s holy presence, into the capital city. During the procession, David unabashedly worships the Lord.

**LESSONS FROM DAVID ON WORSHIPING GOD**

- **Worship that Pleases God is AUTHENTIC.**

*David was dancing before the Lord with **all his might**... V14*

*Yet a time is coming and has now come when the **true worshipers will worship the Father in the Spirit** and in truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks.* John 4.23

- **Worship that Pleases God is ACCURATE.**

(see David in 1 Chronicles 15.13-15)

*Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in the Spirit **and in truth**, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks.* John 4.23

- **Worship that Pleases God COSTS ME.** (v13, 17-19)

*But the king replied to Araunah, “No, I insist on paying you for it. I will not sacrifice to the Lord my God burnt offerings that cost me nothing.”*

2 Samuel 24.24

*Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God’s mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship.* Romans 12.1
