
## GUESS WHO'S COMING TO DINNER Isaiah 25, Luke 14.15-24

D. This End-Time Banquet theme was common with the people during Jesus' day. (Luke 14.15-24)

Jesus provides some 'Invitation Guidelines' to the banquet.

1. The Pre-Party is going on now. (Luke 17.20-21) **DON'T MISS OUT**. Participate in Kingdom activities now!

2. Don't let **EXCUSES** keep you from participating.

3. Don't let **PRIDE** keep you from recognizing that you're not excused. (Isaiah 12.10-12)
