LET'S DO THIS THING Luke 1.26-40

One of the most amazing statements of faith in the bible is Mary's affirmation to the angel's announcement that a child would be miraculously conceived in her who would become the Son of God. This particular act of faith is highlighted in her life, but throughout the Gospels Mary displays an admirable faith, which took root with this one encounter with an angel.

Three truths that help us have a resilient faith like Mary:

1. She remembers her **C**<u>ONFIRMATION</u>.

The angel went to her and said, "Greetings, you who are highly favored! The Lord is with you." Luke 1.28

She hears from God: **I LIKE YOU** and **I'M WITH YOU.**

3. She relies on her **C**OMMUNITY.

At that time Mary got ready and hurried to a town in the hill country of Judea, where she entered Zechariah's home and greeted Elizabeth. Luke 1.39-40

2. She recalls God's **COMMITMENT.**

The angel answered, "The Holy Spirit will come on you, and the powerof the Most High will overshadow you."Luke 1.35
