WHAT TO DO WITH JESUS?

Sabbath observance was an important facet to Jewish religious life. When Jesus and his disciples break the Sabbath laws, they invite the indignation of the law interpreters. Jesus' response to these religious leaders highlights some warning areas for us and provides guidance to us as we continue as Kingdom followers.

Three Warning Areas that Jesus Highlights:

1. Jesus is **LORD OVER ALL.**

Then Jesus said to his disciples, "Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me. Matthew 16.24

2. God's truth is more important than our **INTERPRETATION OF IT**.

There is a way that appears to be right, but in the end it leads to death.

Proverbs 16.25

3. Human <u>NEED</u> is more important than religious or personal <u>TRADITIONS</u>.

"Is not this the kind of fasting I have chosen: to loose the chains of injustice and untie the cords of the yoke, to set the oppressed free and break every yoke? Is it not to share your food with the hungry and to provide the poor wanderer with shelter—when you see the naked, to clothe them, and not to turn away from your own flesh and blood?" Isaiah 58.6-7
