

“IT WILL BE WORTH IT!”

Isaiah 3-4

Isaiah’s message in chapters 3-4 continues with the theme of warning and hope. He begins with the warning—Judah’s failed leadership has led people away from the Lord. But the great, final day of the Lord is both terrible and glorious. Beyond judgment there is blessing.

THE COMING JUDGEMENT Isaiah 3-4.1

A glimmer of encouragement for the righteous in the middle of Isaiah’s tirade:

Tell the righteous it will be well with them, for they will enjoy the fruit of their deeds.

THE FUTURE HOPE Isaiah 4.2-6

1. Salvation: Isaiah 4.1
2. Provision and Abundance: Isaiah 4.2
3. Renewal: Isaiah 4.3-4
4. Protection and Peace: Isaiah 4.5-6

Three actions which can strengthen our belief that following Jesus today will pay off tomorrow. (see Revelation 3.7-11)

1. Don’t make **GIVING UP** an option.

*I know that you have little strength, **yet you have kept my word** and have not denied my name...*

2. Stay true to the **TEACHINGS** of **JESUS**.

...you have kept my word...

3. Cling to the **PROMISES** of **JESUS**.

Hold on to what you have, so that no one will take your crown. Revelation 3.11
