1 Thessalonians 3.1-13, Mark 4.35-41

We sent Timothy....to strengthen and encourage you in your faith, so that no one would be unsettled by these trials. 1 Thessalonians 3.2-3

Mark 4.35-41: Jesus as our example of an undisturbed faith

How to achieve an undisturbed faith:

Be intentional <u>IN GROWING</u> your faith.

May he strengthen your hearts so that you will be blameless and holy in the presence of our God and Father when our Lord Jesus comes. v13

• Find your primary identity IN THE CHURCH.

...For you know quite well that WE are destined for them. In fact, when we were with you, we kept telling you that WE would be persecuted. v3-4

 Walk the two-way street of <u>ENCOURAGEMENT</u>: Give it and receive it.

We sent Timothy....to strengthen and encourage you in your faith... v2

For now we really live, since you are standing firm in the Lord. $\,$ v8

And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but **encouraging one another**—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.

Hebrews 10.24-25

• Don't expect AN EASY LIFE.
