SATAN'S STRATEGIES, JESUS' STRENGTH

Luke 4.1-13

The Gospel writer, Luke, continues to introduce us to Jesus. In this passage, he shares how Jesus was tempted by the devil and how Jesus was able to overcome those temptations.

The three basic areas the devil will tempt us:

- 1. APPETITE v3
- 2. AMBITION vv6-7

3. APPROVAL vv9-11

The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full. John 10.10

Jesus shows us how to combat temptation:

1. He knew WHO HE WAS.

"You are my Son, whom I love; with you I am well pleased." Luke 3.22

____ is a child of God. God loves me. God likes me!

3. Which area of temptation is your 'Achilles heel'? If it is...

Appetite: Implement a FAST

He ate nothing during those days...

Luke 4.2

Ambition: Choose to LOSE

"..the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many." Mark 10.45

In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus: Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death—even death on a cross! Philippians 2.5-8

Approval: Remove YOURSELF

After the people saw the sign Jesus performed, they began to say, "Surely this is the Prophet who is to come into the world." Jesus, knowing that they intended to come and make him king by force, withdrew again to a mountain by himself. John 6.14-15

2. He knew SCRIPTURE. v4,8,12
