**WISDOM IN THE WILDERNESS:  
THE WILDERNESS AS A PLACE OF HUMILITY  
Philippians 2.5-11**

In a world where worth is measured by likes, platforms, and the dream of going viral—where everyone wants to be seen, admired, and applauded—Jesus points us to a different truth. Real success isn't about rising higher but going lower. It's found in service, not celebrity. Christianity uniquely declares that the all-powerful God chose humility—becoming a servant and even dying a shameful death on a cross.

*In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus:*

*Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death—even death on a cross!*

Philippians 2.5-8

**How to Cultivate a Heart of Humility:**

1. Appreciate God's **GREATNESS**. (see Psalm 8)

2. Live into your **IDENTITY** as a **CHILD** of **GOD**.

*"This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased."* Matthew 3.17

*I am less than the least of all the Lord's people...* Ephesians 3.8

*"Do not be afraid, little flock, for your Father has been pleased to give you the kingdom."* Luke 12.32

3. **MODEL** your **LIFE** after Jesus.

- Self-sacrifice. v8
- Serve others. v7
- Use your privileges to bless others. v6

*"For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."* Mark 10.45

*Be devoted to one another in love. Honor one another above yourselves.* Romans 12.10

4. Remember, you are a **WORK** in **PROGRESS**.

*...being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.* Philippians 1.6
