

How to Make Yourself Findable

Luke 19.1-10

Zacchaeus had everything the world said should make him happy—wealth, success, position—yet something inside told him there had to be more. He was lost, and he knew something needed to change. Then one day Jesus came through town, and Zacchaeus saw an opportunity. What he did next just might show us what it looks like for the lost to be found.

“For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost.” Luke 19.10

How to Make Yourself Findable: (in no particular order)

- Embrace the **PAIN**.

The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit. Psalm 34.18

- Follow the **YEARNING** inside.

For God is working in you, giving you the desire and the power to do what pleases him. Philippians 2.13 NLT

- Get over **YOURSELF**.

I will become even more undignified than this....I'll gladly look like a fool. 2 Samuel 6.22 NIV, MSG

- Listen for Jesus' **INVITATION**.

“Look! I stand at the door and knock. If you hear my voice and open the door, I will come in, and we will share a meal together as friends.”

Revelation 3.20 NLT

- Be willing to **SACRIFICE**.

*“If anyone would come after me, **let him deny himself and take up his cross** and follow me. For whoever would save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake **will find it.**”* Matthew 16.24-25

- Live it out **WHERE YOU ARE!**

Nevertheless, each person should live as a believer in whatever situation the Lord has assigned to them, just as God has called them.

1 Corinthians 7.17
